- Performance dates are Saturday October 2, 2010 (Sing-A-Long/Coliseum Blvd. Homecoming)(4 songs) and Thursday October 7, 2010 (Banquet Night)(3 songs)
- Letters will be sent to all Churches of Christ in NC notifying them of the creation of the NCMC and Chorus participation is open to all "faithful" members of the body of Christ within this state
- Each director will teach NCMC a song of their choice (any soloist will be chosen by the director)
- CD's of songs to learn will be given to all members (provided by Coliseum Blvd)
- All current NCMC information will be posted on the Coliseum Boulevard COC website with links from other congregations
- All NCMC participants will be required to purchase a banquet ticket at the price of \$40.00. If you are registered for the Lectureship the \$40.00 banquet fee is included in the registration.
- Payments will be accepted by Sis Karen Adams for those who want to pay on their banquet tickets in advance. This is a non-refundable fee after Saturday, September 4, 2010.
- There will be uniform attire for each performance.
- NCMC directors and participants first meeting will be held at Coliseum Blvd. COC on Saturday January 9, 2010 at 11:00am.
- Rehearsal times will be scheduled prior to each monthly Sing-A-Long.
- All participants must be at least 18 years of age.
